Wardrobe Recommendations



- 1 Bright, Warm Solids are Best (Think coral, teal, purple)
- 2) Avoid White, Red & All Black





- 3 Avoid Tight, Busy Patterns Like Check or Herringbone (They can "buzz" on camera)
- 4 Dress as if You Were Meeting an Important Client (If you're a banker, that would mean a suit; if you're a plumber, wear a golf shirt)



- 5 Don't wear Dangling Jewelry
 (They may make noise that interfereswith audio recording)
- 6 Makeup should be "You, plus 10%" (Wear a little more than you ususally would, and lipstick is a MUST, even if you don't wear it everyday)
 - 7 Get a Haircut One Week Prior to the Shoot (And take special care to groom facial hair the morning of)
- 8 Bring Several Outfit Options (Your producer can help you make a final selection)
